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Côtes du Rhône, Remy Ferbras £5.70 £7.70 £22.95

Warm spiciness without too much tannin. Grenach/Syrah blend offering red fruit flavours and a long, balanced finish

Beaute DU Sud, Malbec £5.95 £8.30 £24.95

A bright youthful ruby red, this is a vivacious and fruit-driven wine full of ripe blackberry character, accented by aromas of eucalyptus and black pepper

Rioja Crianza, Marques de Caceres £26.95

Cherry and blackberry aromas accompanied by Mediterranean herb aromatics, with red cherry and strawberry fruits, cinnamon and silky tannins with a long, silky and spicy finish

Esprit de Lussac, Lussac-St-Emilion, Bordeaux, France £32.95

This is a rich, full bodied wine showing great concentration of flavour. With juicy black fruit on the nose and palate back up by a smokey sandalwood character.
